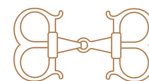

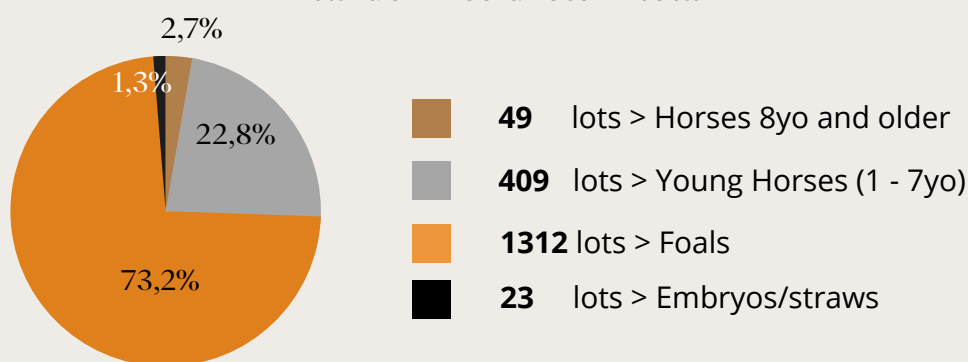

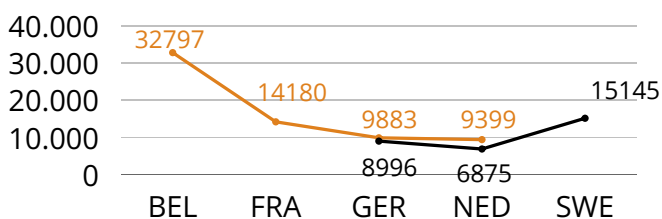

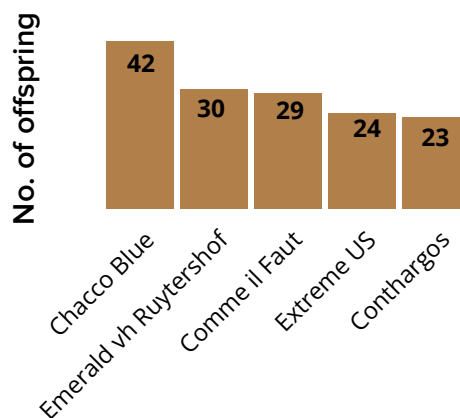


Average foal prices per country

Highest selling auction & individual lots

September is by far the busiest in terms of auctions. Over 1800 embryos, foals and horses were auctioned off the past month! The auction topping the ranks with the highest average and top individual prices was the Top International Auction with three horses selling for over a million euro. Two stallions claimed the highest price of **1,9 million euro** each: 8yo Rolensky MVNZ (Cornet Obolensky x Cassini I) and 6yo Valenzano (Vagabond de la Pomme x Christian 25). The total average was **499.384,00 euro**.

The highest average selling price at an auction purely for foals was at the **Zangersheide Quality Auction** on Saturday night (44.170,73 euro). The most expensive foal was sold in the **Eqbreeding Auction: Dollar Girl vd Bisschop EQ Z** (Dominator Z x Nabab de Reve sold for **170.000 euro**).
